Safeguarding & Child Protection

Pleiades Leisure Limited (PLL) is committed to safeguarding and promoting the welfare of all children and young people in our care. We expect all staff, coaches, contractors and volunteers to share this commitment.

PLL has a comprehensive Safeguarding and Child Protection Policy, supported by clear procedures for identifying, recording and reporting concerns. All staff must be familiar with these procedures, follow them at all times and complete the safeguarding training required for their role.

Our Safeguarding and Child Protection Policy is available to parents, carers, staff and partner organisations on request. Copies of our policies are available through our office and website, or by emailing info@pllgroup.co.uk.

Sharing Safeguarding Information

Where we have concerns about a child's safety or welfare, PLL may need to share relevant information and work in partnership with schools, local authorities, children's social care, the police or other appropriate agencies.

Where appropriate, concerns will be discussed with the child's parent or carer. However, we will not inform parents or carers where doing so could place the child at greater risk, compromise a safeguarding investigation or otherwise be contrary to the child's welfare.

If you have any concern about the safety or welfare of a child, you must report it to the DSL **as soon as possible and on the same day.**

Record the facts clearly, including what you have seen, heard or been told. If a child has spoken to you, record their words as accurately as possible.

Do not investigate the concern yourself, question other people involved or promise confidentiality to a child.

Immediate Danger

If you believe a child is in immediate danger or at immediate risk of serious harm, call 999.

Once the immediate risk has been addressed, inform the DSL as soon as possible and record the concern and any action taken in accordance with PLL's safeguarding procedures.

Concerns or Allegations About Staff or Other Adults

Any concern or allegation regarding the behaviour of a member of staff, coach, contractor or volunteer towards a child must be reported immediately to the DSL and treated confidentially in accordance with PLL's safeguarding procedures.
